A New Adventure with God

After a time of praying and seeking God if we should run the 3rd CDTS, I found myself in the end of September 2007 making the final decision. I felt God spoke to me to lead this school again, that He will be with me and I should trust Him.

The school started on the 1st of November, one month later than usual. Initially we had 4 possible students that were interested to come to the school and also 2 staff, Calin and Mela from Cluj.

For me it was a step in faith, to trust God that He will bring the

school together - students that are hungry and thirsty for God, guestspeakers that had to say yes in a such a short time and also to have one more staff person to help us.

In a short time after we decided to run the CDTS God send us one more staff, we already had 5 students, and we were praying for one more couple. We especially prayed for a couple from the Republik of Moldova. Several days after starting the school, a pastor of a church in Iasi asked as if we would accept a young pastor couple from Moldova. So we

have 7 students.

We as staff are very thankful that we can serve this 7 students for the 5 months of the training course.

In the first part we will get to know God better, understanding our identity in Him and letting Him renew our minds and heal our wounds from the past.

In the second part of the school we will make God known. We will have 8 weeks of outreach and we will serve churches and support different mission organizations, both in Romania and also in cross cultural missions.

Crossroad Discipleship Training school (CDTS) is a school for families and people that are over 30. Many people are at a crossroad in their lives, so our students take 5 months off, to spend time with God, seeking and asking Him for new directions. They want to get a new perspective for their lives, receive healing from past experiences, and take new decisions for their lives.

our pastor couple from Iasi, Romania. They have 5 grown up children. For us it is very exciting to have them with us. Although

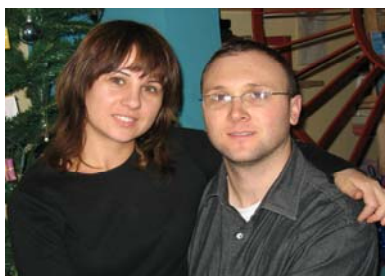
they already know a lot about God, they are still hungry and thirsty for more - to know God better. Their hearts desire is to find out God's plan for their future.
